WHEREAS, Forestville Central School District offers a partial real property tax exemption to senior citizen homeowners whose incomes do not exceed \$14,000, and

WHEREAS, as a result, many senior citizens who were once eligible for the exemptions are no longer eligible due in part to COLA increases in pensions and social security benefits, and

RESOLVED, That effective as of the next taxable status date (March 1, 2008) Forestville Central School does hereby increase the income eligibility limit to \$16,000 for partial real property tax exemption for senior citizens, and be it further

RESOLVED, That the income limit shall be annually increased by an additional \$1,000 per year in each of the four (4) years thereafter.
