

## **V. TRAVEL REGULATIONS**

### **A. Standard Procedures**

All squad members shall ride to and from games in vehicles provided by the district. This is to be considered standard practice. There are times when it may be necessary for a parent to pick up an athlete after a game. This should be cleared with the coach prior to game time and a WRITTEN note to the coach from the parent of the student to be picked up will be required. This note will indicate who the responsible adult picking up the student will be.

### **B. Bus Regulations**

All squad members are expected to conduct themselves in a fashion that will ensure the safety of all passengers. Traveling to and from games should be no different than other times on the bus. All safety rules must be followed. All regulations are also in effect during charter trips.

### **C. Inclement Weather**

Threatening weather may cause a trip to be postponed. The athletic director checks with the athletic director at the opponent school and with Forestville's transportation supervisor for road conditions and recommendations.

In cases where bad weather may threaten a safe journey home, after consulting with the bus driver, the Forestville coach will inform the opposing coach of the need for overnight accommodations. We will make arrangements with other schools to house players either at their school or at their players' homes. We will make arrangements to house other teams if necessary and hope that the Forestville parents and players would assist if called upon to do so. The superintendent may authorize using commercial lodging if it is absolutely necessary. When the coach makes the decision to stay overnight, he/she will contact the athletic director who will contact the parents of the athletes on the trip.
