The New York State Department of Health has revised its guidance on social distancing in schools. The new guidance outlines new social distancing for schools. Students returning to five days a week in-person depends on the infection rates. We are still working through all aspects of the guidance document and will have more information for you as soon as we can. We are continuing to meet regularly to review what this guidance means for our students.

We are still waiting for guidance to be released from the Chautauqua County Department of Health. Once this guidance is shared with us, we will need to review that closely. We want to make sure everyone is safe. We will continue to closely monitor our infection rates as we move through the next few weeks.
