Forestville Central schools is partnering with the Chautauqua County Health Department to host a voluntary and free Covid vaccination clinic for all students ages 12 and older on Monday, May 24th during the school day.

Students who are on Track A, Track C, and five days will already be in attendance on the 24th. Therefore, this is the perfect opportunity for a student to conveniently be vaccinated.

Students who are remote, Track D, and Track B students will have the choice of coming into school on the 24th to be vaccinated. However, we intend to hold additional clinics in the near future on days when these students are in school.

The vaccination for COVID-19 is a personal choice, and not required for school attendance. As more students and individuals are vaccinated, the easier and safer our school will be for the remainder of the

school year and for reopening next fall. If fully vaccinated, students who are exposed to a Covid positive individual will not be named as a close contact and will not be required to quarantine unless they show Covid-like symptoms. This allows students to remain in the classroom and in extracurricular activities.
