*The health and safety of our students and staff is our top priority. This call is to inform you that Forestville Central School District will be going remote tomorrow, Dec 18th, for all students in grades PreK-12. We will be using our normal Wednesday office time schedule.*

*A student in the Forestville High School has tested positive for Covid-19. The student was in school and rode the bus this week. Contact tracing will need to be conducted by the Chautauqua County Health Department with the school's assistance to determine which students and staff members were in close contact with the student that tested positive. If your child was in close contact, the Health Department and the school will contact you.*

*Our Main Offices will remain open tomorrow to answer any questions you may have. We will also follow our normal schedule of remote pickup for families that have chosen full remote.*

*The District cannot release any further details due to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and the Health Insurance Portability & Accounting Act (HIPAA) requirements. We will provide further updates if additional steps need to be taken by our program.*

*We cannot stress this enough, if your child is not feeling well, please have them stay home. If you or your family members have come in contact with anyone that has tested positive for Covid, please stay home. In addition, please contact your healthcare provider if you or anyone in your family develop symptoms or if you have any additional questions or concerns.*
