Project Begins!

Construction has begun and we are all excited to watch the progress! All this work will result in a number of wonderful additions to our facility, not the least of which will be increased building security. The main offices will be relocated to the front of the building allowing us to monitor access much more closely. Another addition that we are really looking forward to is the new auditorium. In addition to the auditorium and the office relocation, one of the many benefits that will result from this project is a brand new kitchen and cafeteria complex. This new facility will allow us to broaden the scope of services that our cafeteria offers to the students in the Middle/High School. In order to make that all possible we will have to work through the typical inconveniences related to a major construction project. Beginning February 23rd we will offer an abbreviated menu to students in grades 6-12. The kitchen and cafeteria will be shut down to enable the renovations and during this time food preparation will take place in the old home economics room on the second floor. Students will be eating on the cafeteria tables placed on the tile floor of the stage in the High School gymnasium. This move will prevent us from cooking as we have done in the past and therefore our menu options will be limited to cold food selections for the remainder of this school year.



A variety of cold sandwiches, subs and salad plates including side dishes such as potato or macaroni salad will be the basic elements of our menu. We will also include a selection of bagged chips along with fresh fruit, canned fruit and milk.
