

The FHMS Health Sciences Award was created for high school students graduating from High School in Chautauqua County. The \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to 3 qualifying students who are enrolling full-time to receive a degree in public health, health science, nursing, or another health-related field.

Who Can Apply

- Open to graduating High School seniors in Chautauqua County.
- Applicants must be enrolled full-time to an accredited college to receive a degree in public health, health science, nursing, or another health-related field.
- Scholarships will be awarded directly to the winners.

How to Apply

- Applicants must submit a 500-word well written personal statement. Please be sure to include your name and high school at the top of your statement.
- Two letters of support (must not be a relative.)
- Provide a copy of high school transcript and college acceptance letter.
- Show dedication to working in the healthcare field.
