We did institute additional safety measures. As students entered the middle/high school, they experienced bag checks. Locker checks also occurred today. We also had staff assigned to continually check our exterior doors to make sure they were secure throughout the day. We also checked all storage areas to make sure they were clear, and nothing suspicious was discovered. We also shifted staff supervision to high traffic areas.

Throughout the day, we had the NYS Troopers drive around our campuses. We also had the Sheriff's Department send an officer over and walk through our buildings. Deputy Hanner, our School Resource Officer (SRO), has also been actively involved in both of our buildings. Our administrators have been as vigilant as always, with our priority being overall school safety.
