Forestville Central Schools is partnering with the Chautauqua County Health Department to host a voluntary and free COVID-19 vaccination clinic for all students on Thursday, March 3rd during the school day. The clinic is open to anyone who had previously received their first dose, as well as anyone looking to receive their booster shot. The vaccination for COVID-19 is a personal choice, and not required for school attendance. As more students and individuals are vaccinated, the easier and safer our school will be for the remainder of the school year and for reopening next fall. If fully vaccinated, students who are exposed to a Covid positive individual will not be named as a close contact and will not be required to quarantine unless they show Covid-like symptoms.
