You, as parents/guardians, can help to prepare your student for sixth grade by reading for fun and information; writing letters or stories; and exploring local historical sites!

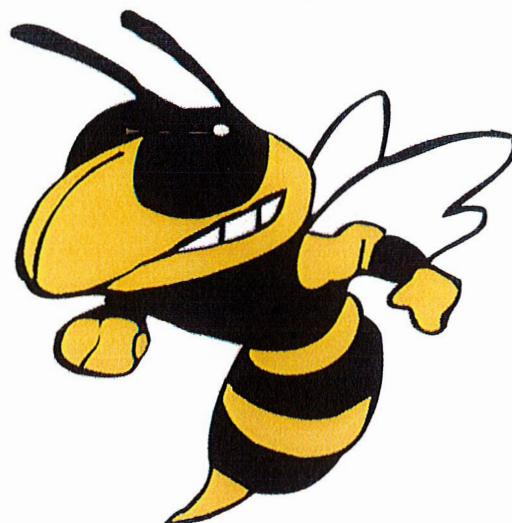
### *School Supplies for 6<sup>th</sup> Grade*
