Dear Parents,

I am very happy to hear that your child will be a part of my 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade class next school year.

I will be connecting you to Class Dojo soon. It will be my primary source of communication just as the 1<sup>st</sup> Grade teachers have done. I will also keep you updated daily with a Parent/Teacher/Student Daily Work Folder, as well as with frequent Newsletters.

As you might have noticed we'll be **GOOFY OVER 2<sup>ND</sup> GRADE!**

Here is the supply list for my 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade. I am requesting that each student comes to class on the first day with his/her own set of supplies so that we can minimize the possible spread of germs.

The list is as follows:

- 4 *vinyl* 3-prong pocket folders  
(*Please select basic colors and I will put their names on them*)
- 1 pair of earbuds or headphones for the Chromebook
- 1 doodle pad (8x10 blank paper pad)
- \* 1 box of 24-count **Crayola** crayons (other brands do not hold up well with use)
- 1 box of 16-count (or 24) colored pencils
- \* 1 pair of **Fiskar** brand student-sized scissors
- 24 #2 standard pencils  
(*Please avoid the plastic-coated ones– they do not sharpen well.*)
- 6 large (gallon-sized) Ziploc slide close storage baggies  
(*I will put names on them*)
- 2 yellow fluorescent Hi-liters
- 2 large pink erasers
- 6-pack \***Expo dry erase** fine point markers (*to be replaced when necessary*)
- 1 large sturdy **pencil box** for pencils/supplies
- \* 3 large **Elmer's** brand glue sticks
- 2 red "teacher ink pens"
- 1 pack of 3x3" Post-It Notes (any color)
- 1 oversized, old -shirt for Art class/messy projects in a labeled gallon-size Ziploc baggie
- 1 package of baby wipes

- 1 Ziploc sandwich baggie with the following coins for Math Class: **10 pennies, 10 dimes, 10 nickels, and 4 quarters (Money will be returned at the end of the year.)**
- 1 plastic 12-inch ruler with inches side **and** centimeters side
- 1 large, sturdy book bag

**I will write your child's name on the 3-prong vinyl folders and Ziploc storage bags.** But, please print your child's name on most of the other items with a permanent marker. I will send a note informing you that something might need to be replaced due to use.

## PHYSICAL EDUCATION NEWS

Your child must have sneakers on PE days. (No Crocs, flip-flops, or sport sandals allowed.) No jewelry (earrings, rings, necklaces, watches) allowed.

If your child must wear glasses during PE, please send a signed permission slip.
